

## Scholarship Information for Seniors

The following list of scholarships will be updated on a weekly basis. Lists will be available in the Guidance Office and on the Guidance webpage. Seniors should check the list on a regular basis. Many applications can be found in the top drawer of the file cabinet in the Guidance Office. Others will only be available via the Internet so check the specifics carefully. If you are taking the last application out of the folder, please let Mr. Police know so that he can make more for other students.

There are instructions for each scholarship and most will be returned to Mr. Police in the Guidance Office. **PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE DEADLINES LISTED ON THE SCHOLARSHIP LIST!** Applications often need to be processed by counselors before being submitted to the sponsoring organization. Applications received after the stated deadline may not be eligible for consideration.

Below are some suggestions to remember when completing scholarship applications:

- 1) BE NEAT AND COMPLETE! Nothing hurts an application more than sloppy handwriting or missing pieces.
- 2) Proofread your final product and have someone else proofread it as well.
- 3) Type/word process applications whenever possible; if applications must be handwritten use black pen (same color throughout).
- 4) When asking others for letters of recommendation, give teachers, employers, coaches, etc. plenty of time to meet the deadline (approximately 2 weeks ahead). Give them a copy of a completed **Request for Letter of Recommendation** form (located in the Guidance Office).
- 5) Keep a copy of all application materials in a personal file.

#### **101 Lakes Kiwanis Club of Angola: Kiwanis Club Scholarship**

- \$500 scholarships awarded to graduating seniors
- Requires application, essay, and transcript
- Deadline: return to Guidance by April 16

#### **Steuben County Lakes Council, Inc.: SCLC Memorial Scholarship**

- \$2400 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior planning to major in Environmental Science or Civil Engineering (preference given to a student attending Trine University)
- Requires application, top 1/3 of class, letter of recommendation, and transcript

#### **NE Indiana Chapter of Whittails Unlimited: Whittails Unlimited Scholarship**

- Scholarship awarded to graduating seniors who have engaged in outdoor activities (hunting and/or fishing)
- Requires application, essay, and photo
- Deadline: April 30

#### **American Legion Auxiliary: AL Fourth District Past Presidents' Parley Scholarship**

- Scholarships awarded to graduating seniors who are children, grandchildren, or great-grandchildren of a current or deceased American Legion Auxiliary member (applicants **MUST** be members of the AL Auxiliary or the Sons of the American Legion) **AND** must be pursuing a career in the medical field
- Requires application, letters of recommendation (3), and transcript

- Deadline: return to Guidance by May 1

#### **Northeastern Center: Jane George Scholarship**

- \$750 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior planning to pursue a career in a mental health profession (counseling, social work, or medicine)
- Requires application and essay

- Deadline: May 21

- Requires attendance at an IN college or university, application, and financial need

#### **Steuben County Community Foundation: Angola Vocational Training Initiative Scholarship**

- Requires application, two years of work history, professional certification or a desire to receive certification, commitment to work in Steuben County, and essay
- Applications are available in Guidance
- Funds will be awarded on a rolling basis until all moneys have been allocated
