

Scholarship Information for Seniors

The following list of scholarships is updated on a weekly basis. Lists will be available in the Guidance Office and on the Guidance webpage. Seniors should check the list on a regular basis. Many applications are found in the top drawer of the file cabinet in the Guidance Office. Others will only be available via the Internet so check the specifics carefully. If you are taking the last application out of the folder, please let Mr. Police know so that he can make more for other students.

There are instructions for each scholarship and most will be returned to Mr. Police in the Guidance Office. **PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE DEADLINES LISTED ON THE SCHOLARSHIP LIST!** Applications often need to be processed by counselors before being submitted to the sponsoring organization. Applications received after the stated deadline may not be eligible for consideration.

Below are some suggestions to remember when completing scholarship applications:

- 1) BE NEAT AND COMPLETE! Nothing hurts an application more than sloppy handwriting or missing pieces.
- 2) Proofread your final product and have someone else proofread it as well.
- 3) Type/word process applications whenever possible; if applications must be handwritten use black pen (same color throughout).
- 4) When asking others for letters of recommendation, give teachers, employers, coaches, etc. plenty of time to meet the deadline (approximately 2 weeks ahead). Give them a copy of a completed **Senior Data Form** (print or share via Google). Make sure to let recommenders know specific submission guidelines: printed letter, online recommendation, etc.
- 5) Keep a copy of all application materials in a personal file.

IF YOU SEND AN EMAIL TO A TEACHER, COUNSELOR, OR OTHER RECOMMENDER, MAKE SURE TO CHECK FOR A RESPONSE! IF YOU DON'T READ EMAIL, THEN DON'T SEND EMAIL!!!!

- \$2000 scholarships awarded to graduating seniors in a variety of categories (AHS may only nominate 1 student)
- Requires application, leadership, community service, essay, and letters of recommendation (only if chosen as AHS nominee)
- Pick up nomination information in the Guidance Office
- Deadline: to be considered as the AHS nominee, return all materials by October 29

Scholarships (state/national):

Acceptance Insurance: Heisman High School Scholarship Program

- \$1000-\$10000 scholarships awarded to graduating seniors who have been members of a high school athletic team (AHS will have 1 male and 1 female school winner who will move on to state competition)
- Requires application, participation in a high school sport, demonstrated leadership, and GPA at least 8.0/12.0; include Mr. Police's email address (dpolice@msdsc.us) for the reviewer information
